The pre-school camp is designed especially for the little ones ages 3 - 5 years (Pre-K). Champions attend a half-day session that runs Monday - Friday 9 am - 1 pm. ## Champion Camp Fees

- Camp tuition for the 'Champions': \$290/week (\$315 if paid after 4/1/12)
- 2 day pre-school program (Tu/Th) is \$116/week (\$141 if paid after 4/1/12)
- 3 day pre-school program (M/W/F) is \$174/week (\$199 if paid after 4/1/12)
- No camp July 4th. \$116/week (\$141 if paid after 4/1/12)
- Full day available for Champions, please call for details.
- Pre-pay for 6 full weeks and receive a \$20 per week discount. Half day campers receive a \$10 per week discount.



## Extended Day

Extended Care is available for all campers from 8 am - 9 am and 4 pm - 6 pm. Extended care activities may include free choice, outside play, gym time, arts & crafts, movie time and board games. Cost is \$10 per hour with quantity discounts available.



## Longfellow Aquatics Academy

Our swim school has been in session for over 19 years. All campers receive daily Red Cross swimming lessons, Monday through Thursday, taught by certified instructors. The pool is well supervised by lifeguards and counselors at all times. Campers also have a free swim choice in the afternoons.
