

Welcome to Longfellow Arts Camp!

Our camp runs from June 26 through August 18, 2006. Enrollment is on a pre-paid basis in two-week sessions. We hope this brochure is helpful in explaining the basic features of our camp. Longfellow Arts Camp welcomes children ranging from those entering kindergarten (Fall '05) through 7th graders (Fall '05). Enrollment is limited and children are assigned to one of two groups based on their age.

Camp Sessions, Hours & Fees

Longfellow Arts Camp has four 2-week sessions:

- June 26-July 7 (no camp on July 3rd and 4th), \$590 before 4/1/06 and \$630 after 4/1/06.
- July 10-21, \$740 before 4/1/06 and \$790 after 4/1/06.
- July 24-August 4, \$740 before 4/1/06 and \$790 after 4/1/06.
- August 7-18, \$740 before 4/1/06 and \$790 after 4/1/06.

Children must be enrolled for two consecutive weeks as described above. Camp hours are Monday-Friday, 8:45 am-4:15 pm. Dropoff is 8:45-9:00 am and pickup is 4:00-4:15 pm. Counselors will escort children to and from their parent's cars.

Extended Care

Extended care is available from 8:00 am-6:00 pm (breakfast is served from 8:00-8:30 am) with a camper:counselor ratio of 8:1. Extended care activities may include basketball, wiffle ball, dodge ball, arts and crafts, quiet board games, and outdoor play. Cost is \$10 per hour and quantity discounts are available. Great Lunch Everyday

Each day campers are offered an array of fresh fruits and vegetables as well as sandwich fillings, pastas, salads, breads and a daily hot lunch special. Counselors assist the campers in choosing healthy, appealing and satisfying mid-day meals. A camp lunch staff is on hand at all times to serve the needs of the children. Special dietary needs can always be accommodated. Best of all, no lunch to pack!

Campers must supply a completed medical form that is less than one-year old that includes documentation of required immunizations.
