

## Welcome to Camp Longfellow

Our camp runs from June 26 through August 25, 2006. Enrollment is on a pre-paid, weekly basis. We hope this brochure is helpful in explaining the basic features of our camp. Camp Longfellow welcomes children ages 12 months to 14 years of age. A half-day camp option is available for preschool campers only. All full-day campers kindergarten and older participate in the camp's core activities with tennis and swimming lessons organized by age and ability. Our camper to counselor ratios (3:1 for toddlers; 4:1 for preschoolers; 5:1 for kindergarten and first graders; 6:1 for second and third graders; 8:1 for fourth grade and up) allow for lots of individual attention.

## Camp Hours & Fees

Monday-Friday, 8:45 am-4:15 pm. Dropoff is 8:45-9:00 am and pickup is 4:00-4:15 pm. Counselors escort children to and from their parent's or guardian's cars.

- Camp tuition is \$370 per week (\$395 per week after 4/1/06).
- A half-day option (9 am - 1 pm) is available for toddler and preschool campers only and is \$270 per week (\$295 after 4/1/06).
- Lady Bug Camp for campers 12 months-2.9 years old), Tuesday/Thursday: \$100 per week (\$110 after 4/1/06) or Monday/Wednesday/Friday: \$150 per week (\$165 after 4/1/06).
- Lady Bug Camp is 9:00 am-1:00 pm.
- CIT tuition is \$580 per 2-week session (\$630 if paid after 4/1/06).

Pre-pay for 6 weeks and receive a \$20 per week discount. Please note that half-day campers may not participate in all of the activities listed in this brochure.

## Extended Care

Extended care is available from 8:00-9:00 am (breakfast is served from 8:00-8:30 am) and 4:00-6:00 pm with a camper/counselor ratio of 6:1. Extended care activities may include basketball, wiffle ball, dodge ball, arts and crafts, quiet board games, and outdoor play. Cost is \$10 per hour and quantity discounts are available. Please register with Karen Mahoney. Flexible schedules accommodated.

## Longfellow Children's Center

Campers enjoy spending time at our fabulous facility. Kids rule as they play in the coolest treehouse ever built indoors and The Amazing Maze climbing structure. The Longfellow Children's Center is adjacent to The Longfellow Club, just a few steps away. Camp dropoff and pickup at this great facility provides for a hassle-free and smooth transition for kids and parents. The Longfellow Children's Center has a spacious outdoor play area including the Jupiter climbing structure and separate preschool play space.

## Great Lunch Everyday for Everyone!

Each day campers are offered an array of fresh fruits and vegetables as well as sandwich fillings, pastas, salads, breads and a daily hot lunch special. Counselors assist the campers in choosing healthy, appealing and satisfying mid-day meals. A camp lunch staff is on hand at all times to serve the needs of the children. Special dietary needs can always be accommodated. Best of all, no lunch to pack!

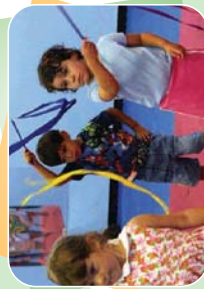

## Longfellow Swim School

All campers over 2.9 years of age receive daily Red Cross swimming lessons at the appropriate level taught by qualified instructors. Our swim school has been in session for over sixteen years. Campers are also allowed afternoon free swim time, and are supervised by lifeguards and camp staff at all times.

## Tennis with the Pros

All full-day campers kindergarten and up are introduced to tennis and taught at the appropriate level twice per week. The Longfellow Club has perhaps the most dynamic year-round junior tennis program in New England and campers enjoy being taught by such high-quality tennis professionals.



## Lady Bugs

This program for our littlest campers is a lot of fun! Lady Bug activities include arts and crafts, dance, music and movement, daily baby pool activities, and outdoor activities. In addition, story and rest times are built into the day. Lunch is included! Choose between a Monday-Wednesday-Friday or Tuesday-Thursday option from 9:00 am-1:00 pm to fit your schedule. Extended day coverage is available.

## Grasshoppers

Preschool group with minimum age of 2.9 years (must be toilet trained). A camp-within-a-camp for the little guys with a focus on fun through socialization with "down time" built right in. Preschool campers can choose between a 9:00-1:00 or a 9:00-4:00 schedule. Lunch is included. Activities include:

- Experiential art
- Swimming lessons
- Circle/story time
- Outdoor fun and free play
- Music and games
- Sports introduction
- Dance and gymnastics

## Fireflies & Dragonflies

Fireflies are children entering kindergarten and first grade and Dragonflies are children entering second and third grade as of the Fall 2006. These age groups are more able to tackle a full day than the Lady Bugs and Grasshoppers and the activities reflect this maturity. Activities include:

- Age-appropriate, themed art projects emphasizing creativity
- Daily outdoor activities including games, relay races and free play
- Dance and basketball
- In addition to all the activities listed above, Sports Director T.C. Leeger offers a sports instruction program for both Fireflies and Dragonflies.

## Adventurers

For children entering fourth grade and up, many varied activities are offered, with a focus on individual choice.

- Sports conditioning
- Dance and fitness classes
- Board games
- Intricate art projects
- Sports: floor hockey, volleyball, basketball, football and soccer
- Tae KwonDo and kickboxing

No deduction is allowed for late arrival or early departure. Camp Longfellow maintains the highest safety standards; however, it does not assume liability for accidents, illness, or disease.  
Campers must supply a completed medical form that is less than one-year old that includes documentation of required immunizations. It is hereby understood and agreed that any accident or sickness claim will be covered by the parent's or guardian's insurance.
